New Mons age group fee proposal

Membership increase is the single highest priority of the Association and the Board is seeking your assistance to reach a target of 20% increase for 2017-19.

We believe the 20% target is easily achievable by following the Association's policy of registering new players after a maximum of four weeks of temporary membership and timely annual renewal for continuing members.

After considering a proposal from a member club at its meeting on 14 March 2017, the Judo Queensland Board would like to reduce the Mons age group membership fee from \$70 to \$50. Mons age is 8 years and under.

The basis for the reduction is to stimulate junior sign on and offset the start-up cost for families with young judo players. Some clubs wish to try to register a higher number of Mons members with this new fee level.

Also with the new fee, any Mons members who have already registered in 2017 will be eligible to be compensated for having paid a higher fee with a free grade certificate. Clubs may apply for the compensatory grade certificates in one transaction via an email to the office which lists the names of the players for which the certificates are claimed.

There are a few system and IT updates we need to make before the change is official so we'd appreciate input prior to 28th April, approximately three weeks from today.

Short of any strong objections that warrant further investigation, the change will be in effect in early May 2017 in time for term 2 sign-on.
