PLEASE NOTE:

- All selected Athletes must satisfy the minimum eligibility requirements set out in clause 3 of the Selection Criteria published on the JFA website.
- Acceptance Forms** – A completed signed Acceptance Form (**attached**) must be sent to hp@ausjudo.com.au at your earliest convenience but no later than COB on Thursday 15 March 2018 to accept selection. The reason for the fast turnaround is that the IJF requires athletes to be entered in Judobase 20 days prior to the commencement of the competition which is Friday, 16 March.
- Support Team:** - Team Manager – Natalie Galea, Coaches are Maria Pekli and Gavin Kelly.
- Funding** – no JFA Funding is provided towards this event. However, AWE athletes will have their accommodation paid for by the AIS Combat Centre.

The total cost is estimated between \$1,000 and \$1,500 depending on the cost of the flights. This does not include meals.

Athletes are asked to book their own flights to Noumea. Cadets and Juniors must arrive to Noumea by Thursday, 5 April 2018 and Seniors must arrive by Friday, 6 April 2018. We will not stay for the proposed training camp.

Please send your air ticket to Natalie Galea to natalie_galea@yahoo.com.au. Natalie will coordinate the team and make sure that underage athletes will have an adult with them on their flights.

Accommodation has been booked by the JFA.

- IJF ID Cards** – Athletes who do not have a current IJF ID card must contact Cathy Potter in the JFA Office immediately to obtain one. Athletes cannot enter this competition without an IJF ID card. The cost of the IJF card is \$95.
- Australian Uniform** – all athletes are required to wear the dark blue Australian uniform. If you don't have one please contact Cathy Potter or try to borrow a set from someone in your state.

- **Australian back patches** – Each Australian competitor is required to have sewn onto the back of their judogi a back patch bearing their surname and the Australian Olympic Committee abbreviation (i.e., AUS). If you do not have a back patch yet, please order it now from www.ijfbacknumber.com or www.mybacknumber.com. It will take some time to arrive as it is sent from overseas. With the back patches you will receive instructions as to how to sew them onto your gi. Please observe these instructions.
- **IJF Approved judo gi** – all competitors are required to compete in the latest IJF approved gis with the red label. Your belt can be blue label but must be the same brand. The belt rules don't apply to kyu grade competitors.
